2026 WCCC Social Run & Treasure Hunt.

We began with nine questions relating to the fascinating history (and female fortitude) of this unique building. Thankfully, members were spared the 130-step climb to the top! (I hope you all remember what a bathtub key is used for!)



It was then a five-mile jaunt along our lovely coast, passing through Moreton and Meols before arriving at Hoylake Lifeboat Station. This impressive site revealed repeated acts of bravery and

Next, we enjoyed a 19-mile drive through more beautiful parts of the Wirral—including West Kirby, Parkgate, and Thornton Hough—before arriving at Poulton Hall. Mersey Tunnel Tour 14th & 28th March 2026

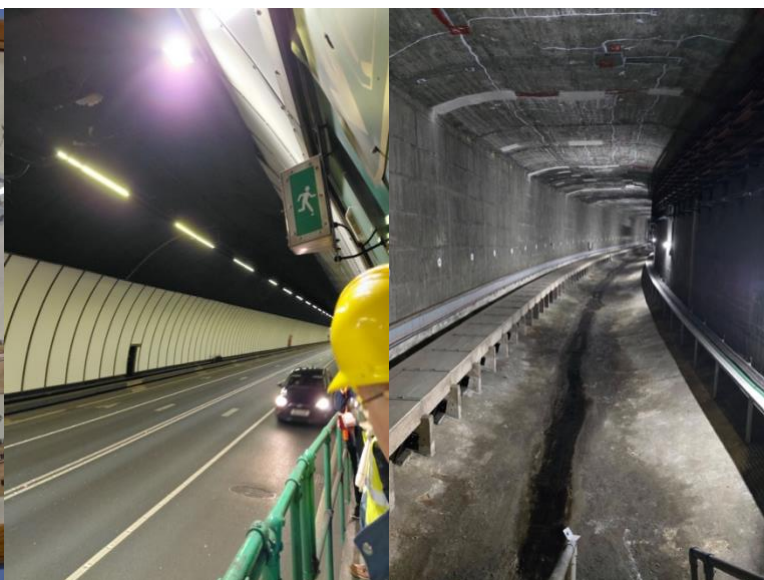
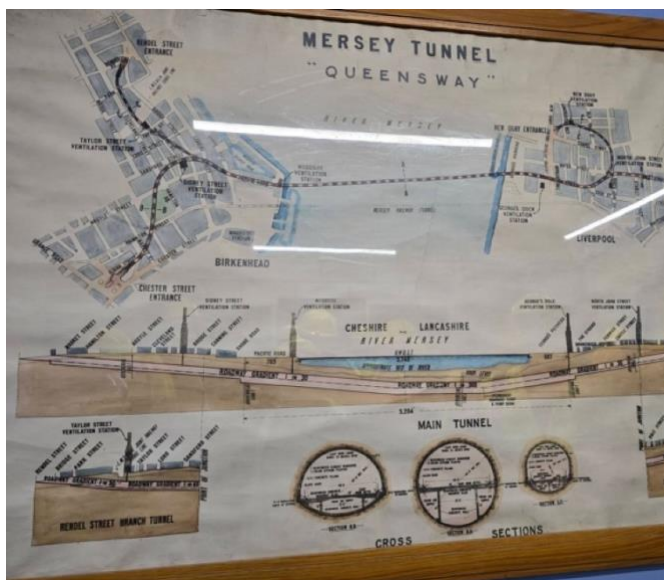
In March Ken Glass organised 2 trips to the Mersev Tunnel. A
