parked within the barriers on the opposite side to the field organised by Port Sunlight Village Trust (PSVT). They also organised stalls on the

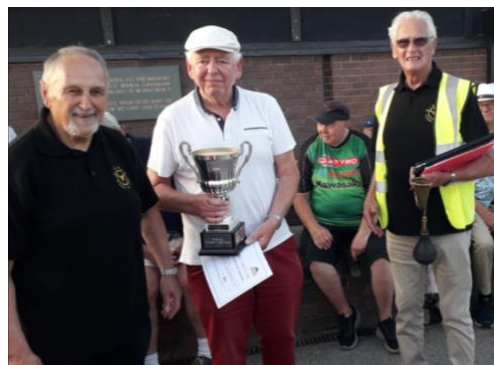


Car of the Year June Club Night
